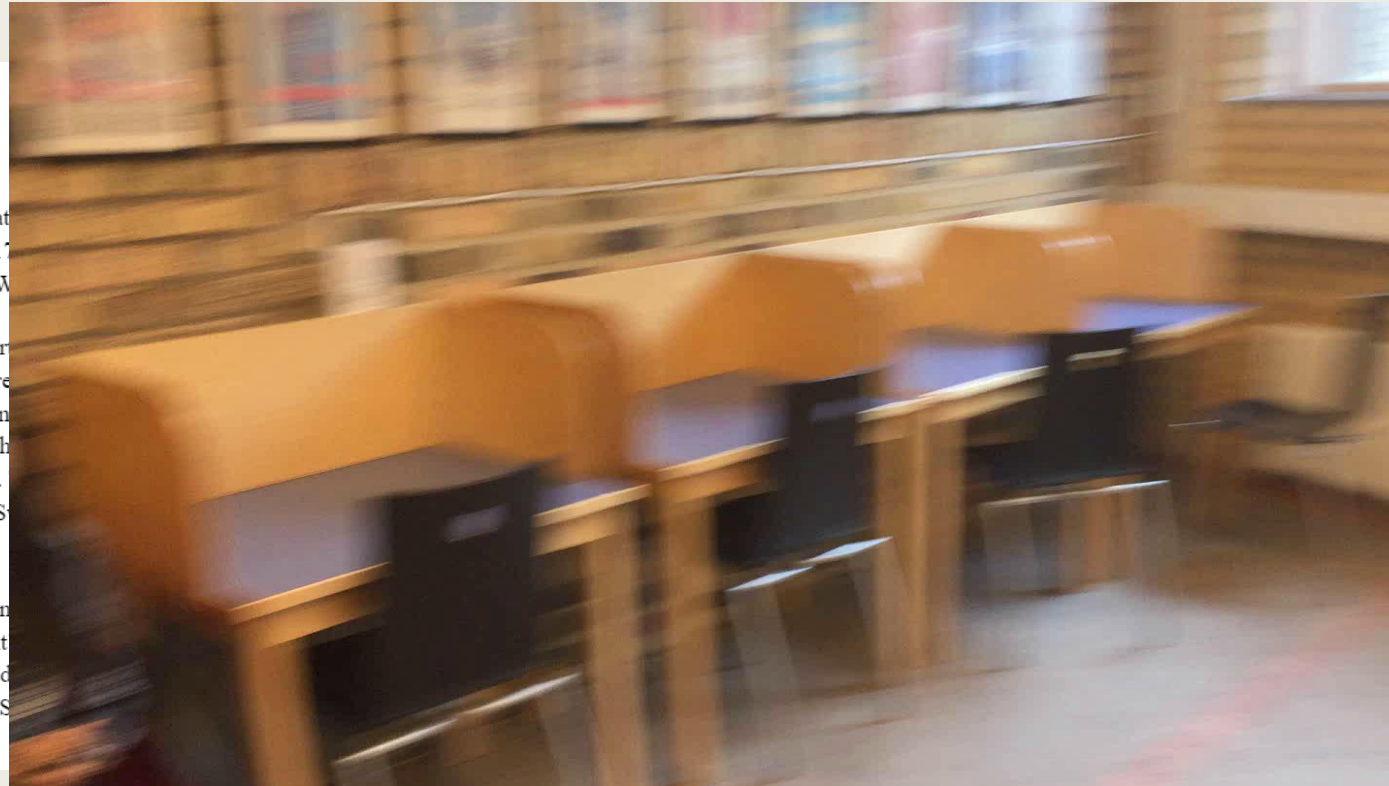

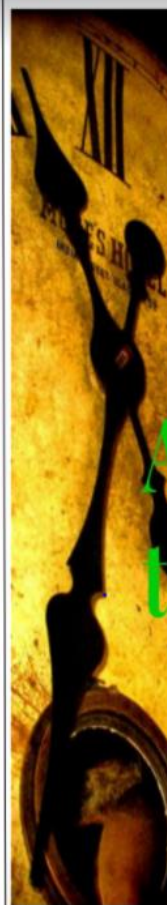

Hello NAC2 my name is Mingus and I've read the book about South Africa.

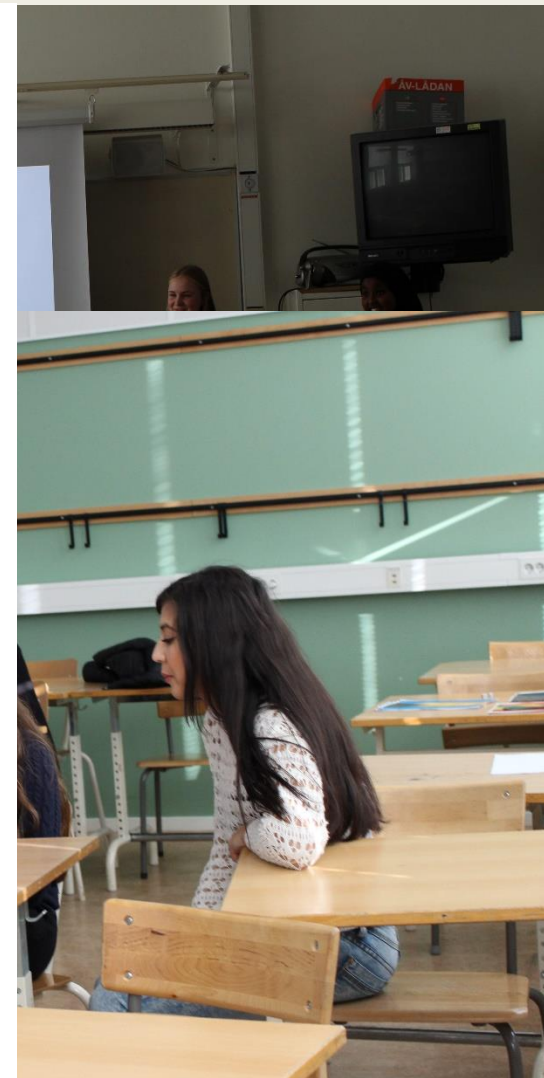
