Local transportation

City buses number 1, 6 and 20 can be used to get from Lund Central Station to the Centre for Mathematical Sciences. The bus stops near the Centre for Mathematical Sciences are called Professorsgatan (bus no 1) and Vattentorget (bus no 6 and 20). See the map. You can pay by card onboard the city buses, but cash is not accepted. Speakers and poster presenters will be offered free tickets during registration. See skanetrafiiken.se for timetables and other information.

Wireless Internet access

Eduroam is the easiest option if you have an account through your home university. If you don't have an Eduroam account, you can use the LU Guest network:

1. Choose LU Guest amongst your available networks on your device and connect to it.
2. Start a web browser on your device.
3. You should get to a webpage that asks for registration by e-mail or SMS. If you don't get to the webpage automatically, just try to surf to a random page and it will direct you to it.
4. Choose to register through e-mail or SMS.
5. Type in your name and your e-mail address or your phone number. Accept the terms of use and click on "Register".
6. Type in the code you'll receive on your e-mail or SMS depending on which option you chose before, and click on "Log in".

There are two cafés close to the museum (Café Tycho Brahe and Pumpans café & restaurang). There is also a bus connecting Bäckviken and the museum and a bike rental near Bäckviken. Please contact the organizers if you are interested in renting a bike. *The boat leaves again from Bäckviken harbour at 17.45.* We expect to be back in Lund around 19.00. The bus will drop you off in the city centre, close to Hotel Lundia and Grand Hotel.
